- 1) **H.Res. 23** – Honoring the contributions of Catholic schools (*Rep. Kennedy (MN) – Education & the Workforce*)
- 2) **H.R. 120** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 30777 Rancho California Road in Temecula, California, as the "Dalip Singh Saund Post Office Building" (*Rep. Issa – Government Reform*)
- 3) **H.R. 289** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 8200 South Vermont Avenue in Los Angeles, California, as the "Staff Sergeant First Class John Marshall Post Office Building" (*Rep. Waters – Government Reform*)

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2005

The House will meet at 10:00 a.m. for legislative business. The House Floor will be cleared by 5:00 p.m. in order to prepare the House Chamber for the President's State of the Union Address. The House will reconvene at approximately 8:45 p.m. to begin the joint session with the Senate for the purpose of receiving a State of the Union Address from the President of the United States.

- 1) **H.Res. ____** – Commending the Palestinian people for holding recent elections (*Rep. Blunt / Rep. Hoyer – International Relations*)
- 2) **H.Res. ____** – Expressing the strong concern of the House of Representatives that the European Union may end its arms embargo against the People's Republic of China (*Rep. Hyde – International Relations*)

H.Con.Res. ____ – Expressing the continued support of Congress for equal access of military recruiters to institutions of higher education (*Rep. Hunter – Armed Services*)
