- 2) **H.R. 548** - To designate the United States courthouse at 200 West 2nd Street, Dayton, Ohio, as the "Tony Hall Federal Building and United States Courthouse" (Rep. Hobson - Transportation & Infrastructure)

- 2) **H.Con.Res. 26** - Honoring the Tuskegee Airmen for their bravery in fighting for our freedom in World War II, and for their contribution in creating an integrated United States Air Force (Rep. Rogers (AL) - Armed Services)
- 3) **H.Con.Res. 30** - Supporting the goals and ideals of National Black HIV/AIDS Awareness Day (Rep. Lee - Energy & Commerce)
- 4) **H.Res. 46** - Supporting the goals and ideals of National Mentoring Month (Rep. Osborne - Education & the Workforce)
