Votes will be postponed until approximately 5:00 p.m.

### Suspensions (4 bills):

- 1) **S.Con.Res. 79** – A concurrent resolution expressing the sense of Congress that no United States assistance should be provided directly to the Palestinian Authority if any representative political party holding a majority of parliamentary seats within the Palestinian Authority maintains a position calling for the destruction of Israel (*Sen. Thune – International Relations*)
- 2) **H.Con.Res. 300** – Paying tribute to Shirley Horn in recognition of her many achievements and contributions to the world of jazz and American culture (*Rep. Conyers – Education and the Workforce*)
- 3) **S. 2275** – National Flood Insurance Program Further Enhanced Borrowing Authority (*Sen. Shelby – Financial Services*)
- 4) **H.R. 4745** – Making supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2006 for the Small Business Administration's disaster loans program, and for other purposes (*Rep. Lewis {CA} – Appropriations*)
