The House will meet at 12:30 p.m. for morning hour and 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. Votes will be postponed until 6:30 p.m.

- 1) **H.R. 794** – Colorado River Indian Reservation Boundary Correction Act (*Rep. Grijalva – Resources*)
- 2) **H.R. 585** – Gateway Communities Cooperation Act (*Rep. Radanovich – Resources*)
- 3) **H.R. 18** – Southern California Groundwater Remediation Act (*Rep. Baca – Resources*)
- 4) **H.R. 541** – To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain land to Lander County, Nevada, and the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain land to Eureka County, Nevada, for continued use as cemeteries (*Rep. Gibbons – Resources*)
- 5) **H.R. 482** – Pine Springs Land Exchange Act (*Rep. Neugebauer – Resources*)

- 2) **H.R. 483** – To designate a United States courthouse in Brownsville, Texas, as the "Reynaldo G. Garza and Filemon B. Vela United States Courthouse" (*Rep. Ortiz – Transportation & Infrastructure*)
- 3) **H.R. 787** – To designate the United States courthouse located at 501 I Street in Sacramento, California, as the "Robert T. Matsui United States Courthouse" (*Rep. Thompson {CA} – Transportation & Infrastructure*)

H.R. 8 – Permanent Estate Tax Repeal Act of 2005 (*Rep. Hulshof – Ways & Means*) (*Subject to a Rule*)

S. 256 – Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (*Sen. Grassley – Judiciary*) (*Subject to a Rule*)
