The House will convene at 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. Votes will be postponed until 6:30 p.m.

Suspensions (5 bills):

- 1) **H.R. 4381** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 2811 Springdale Avenue in Springdale, Arkansas, as the "Harvey and Bernice Jones Post Office Building" (*Rep. Boozman – Government Reform*)
- 2) **H.R. 4442** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1050 North Hills Boulevard in Reno, Nevada, as the "Guardians of Freedom Memorial Post Office Building" and to authorize the installation of a plaque at such site (*Rep. Gibbons – Government Reform*)
- 3) **H.R. 4556** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1115 South Clinton Avenue in Dunn, North Carolina, as the "General William Carey Lee Post Office Building" (*Rep. Etheridge – Government Reform*)
- 4) **H.R. 4618** – To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 10 West Prospect Street in Nanuet, New York, as the "Anthony I. Lombardi Memorial Post Office Building" (*Rep. Engel – Government Reform*)
- 5) **H.R. 4654** – To reauthorize the Tropical Forest Conservation Act of 1998 through fiscal year 2007 (*Rep. Putnam – International Relations*)
