Suspensions (12 bills):

- 1) **H.R. 1564** – Yakima-Tieton Irrigation District Conveyance Act of 2005 (*Rep. Hastings – Resources*)
- 2) **H.R. 1972** – Franklin National Battlefield Study Act (*Rep. Blackburn – Resources*)
- 3) **H.R. 3507** – Pechanga Band of Luiseno Mission Indians Land Transfer Act of 2005 (*Rep. Issa – Resources*)
- 4) **H.R. 3721** – To amend the Omnibus Parks and Public Lands Management Act of 1996 to allow certain commercial vehicles to continue to use Route 209 within Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area and to allow the National Park Service to continue to collect fees from those vehicles, and for other purposes (*Rep. Sherwood – Resources*)
- 5) **H.R. 3981** – To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out certain land exchanges involving small parcels of National Forest System land in the Tahoe National Forest in the State of California, and for other purposes (*Rep. Doolittle – Resources*)
- 6) **S.161** – Northern Arizona Land Exchange and Verde River Basin Partnership Act of 2005 (*Sen. McCain – Resources*)
- 7) **H.R. 318** – To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to study the suitability and feasibility of designating Castle Nugent Farms located on St. Croix, Virgin Islands, as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes (*Del. Christensen – Resources*)
- 8) **H.R. 323** – To redesignate the Ellis Island Library on the third floor of the Ellis Island Immigration Museum, located on Ellis Island in New York Harbor, as the "Bob Hope Memorial Library" (*Rep. Engel – Resources*)
- 9) **H.R. 326** – To amend the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area Act of 2000 to adjust the boundary of the Yuma Crossing National Heritage Area and to extend the authority of the Secretary of the Interior to provide assistance under that Act (*Rep. Grijalva – Resources*)
- 10) **H.R. 1790** – Child Medication Safety Act of 2005 (*Rep. Kline – Education and the Workforce*)
- 11) **H.R. 856** – Federal Youth Coordination Act (*Rep. Osborne – Education and the Workforce*)
- 12) **H.Con.Res. 288** – Recognizing the 30th anniversary of the enactment of the Education for All Handicapped Children Act of 1975 and reaffirming support for the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act so that all children with disabilities have access to a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment (*Rep. Castle – Education and the Workforce*)
