## FLOOR SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE

**At 10:00 a.m. the Supplemental Appropriations Conference Report will be filed. The Conference Report is an acceptable compromise for the Democratic Leadership and the Appropriations Committee Democrats. No recorded vote is required or expected. However, any Member may request a recorded vote --- although none is anticipated at this time.**

**H.R. 1559 – Supplemental Appropriations Conference Report for FY2003 (Under Unanimous Consent).** The Appropriations Conference Report includes 26 weeks of unemployment assistance for airline workers and restrictions on the use of funds to protect congressional authority.

Additional information on the Appropriations Conference Report will be provided as it becomes available.
