## FLOOR SCHEDULE AND PROCEDURE

The House will convene at 12:30 p.m. for morning hour and 2:00 p.m. for legislative business. Votes will be postponed until 6:30 p.m.

- 1) **H.Res. 66** - Supporting responsible fatherhood and encouraging greater involvement of fathers in the lives of their children, especially on Father's Day (*Rep. Sullivan - Ed & Work*)
- 2) **H.R. 1610** - To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 120 East Ritchie Avenue in Marceline, Missouri, as the "Walt Disney Post Office Building" (*Rep. Graves - Government Reform*)
- 3) **H.R. 2030** - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 120 Baldwin Avenue in Paia, Maui, Hawaii, as the "Patsy Takemoto Mink Post Office Building" (*Rep. Case - Government Reform*)
- 4) **H.Con.Res. 162** - Honoring the city of Dayton, Ohio, and its many partners, for hosting "Inventing Flight: The Centennial Celebration", a celebration of the centennial of Wilbur and Orville Wright's first flight (*Rep. Turner {OH} - Government Reform*)
- 5) **H.R. 925** - To redesignate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 1859 South Ashland Avenue in Chicago, Illinois, as the "Cesar Chavez Post Office" (*Rep. Gutierrez - Government Reform*)
- 6) **S. 763** - To designate the Federal building and United States courthouse located at 46 East Ohio Street in Indianapolis, Indiana, as the "Birch Bayh Federal Building and United States Courthouse" (*Rep. Carson {IN} - T & I*)
